RE: High School Material Drop Off and Pick-up

Dear Jesup High School Students and Parents:

We have formulated a plan for all students across the district to turn in any school materials they have at home and to pick up the contents of their locker. We are going to follow the same process we used with our seniors that worked very efficiently.

There are two days when students or parents can come and drop off textbooks, library books, or any school devices they may have at home. The dates and times are listed below.

- **Wednesday, May 27th from Noon – 8:00 PM**
- **Thursday, May 28th from 8:00 AM – Noon.**

High school pick up and drop off will be at the **Jesup Middle School entrance**. We ask that you pull up to the entrance in the fire lane and stay in your vehicle. A staff member outside will take your name, collect the materials being turned in, and will retrieve the student's materials from inside the school and bring them back out to you.

If you have siblings or students in different buildings, you will need to go to each building to turn in and collect materials. We will not be grouping materials by family across buildings.
